Credit rating agencies have been heavily criticized for their role in the current financial crises. Regarding the Lehman bankruptcy rating agencies were accused of acting too late. With respect to the current Greece crisis rating agencies were accused of acting too fast and thus aggravate the country's financial situation. These criticisms have sparked renewed interest in the fundamental role of rating agencies as certifying intermediaries and the possible need for their regulation.

The goal of the conference is to bring together the latest academic research on credit rating agencies and certification in general, and to provide a forum to discuss a wide range of theoretical and empirical issues as well as policy implications relating to credit rating agencies.

Areas of interest include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Effects of disclosure rules and regulation for rating agencies
- The economics of certification
- The role of credit rating agencies during the financial crises
- Efficient provision of unbiased credit ratings
- Rating performance
- Syndication and securitization
