On October, 22nd, 2009, we will inform the applicants if they are permitted to participate in the seminar or which order of priority they are given on the waiting list.

On **October 27th, 2009** from 10.00 to 11:30 am in room 21 A (Spandauer Str. 1) all seminar topics will be allocated. This event is for accepted students only and for those that are told to be on the waiting list. Please, bring the money for accommodation (see below) with you!

The length of your seminar paper should not exceed 15 pages. The paper has to be submitted until January 21st, 2009 (12:00 noon).

You are expected to hold a presentation during the seminar and to attend all sessions and presentations. Accommodation will cost around 35 € per night, half board, plus travelling and leisure time expenses. Exact costs depend on the number of participants and will be communicated as soon as possible.
